EYFS and Year 1 & 2 – Miss Allwood

EYFS have had a lovely week exploring and practising on the balance bikes. The children have really enjoyed building their confidence and developing their coordination, and we have been focusing on how to stay safe while using them, including taking turns, being aware of others and moving around the space carefully.

Year 1 have been working hard on their 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We have been using a range of practical activities, games and songs to help the children become more confident with recalling these facts quickly.
