EYFS and Year 1 & 2 – Miss Allwood



EYFS have been enjoying learning about summer and exploring how the seasons have changed throughout the year. The children have enjoyed discussing the signs of summer and comparing them to the other seasons, even though the weather has not always cooperated! They have been spotting changes in the environment and talking about what makes each season special.

Year 1 have been enjoying exploring numbers to 10 and are doing a fantastic job developing their confidence with counting, recognising numbers and solving simple mathematical problems.

This week in KS2, in English we have been looking at different types of poetry, and writing a haiku, following all the rules we need to. These haikus are based off a picture from the Heroes of Troy play we are going to be performing at the end of the half term. We have also started reading the play and assigning parts, so the children may be coming home and practising their lines. In Maths, Year 4's have been finishing their decimal knowledge, which involved partitioning, ordering and comparing decimals. Year 5 have been looking at statistics and how we interpret different types of data and graphs. Year 6 have been revisiting fractions, percentages and decimals and finding equivalents within them.

In Music this week we have started to learn the songs for our end of year play; the children are beginning to pick up a few of the lyrics but are really excited about the play. In DT we made and drew some simple circuits, thinking about what components we need and how a switch can affect their circuit.

Sports Day

On Wednesday 24th June, all children from Nursery to Year 6 will be taking part in our sports day.

This will take place at Stillington Sports Hall. Children from Terrington and Foston will be taken across by bus, which will leave school immediately after registration. Children from Stillington will walk down with staff from school.

Parents and families are invited to join us from 12.15pm and may take their children home with them when sports day has finished roughly around 1.45pm. Buses will still be provided for those children who need them and will return to school before the end of the school day. Afterschool clubs will take place as usual. **Please can you let your school office know if you are taking your children home after sports day.**

All children should come to school in their PE kit, which is a white t-shirt, black shorts or jogging bottoms and trainers. Children should also wear their school jumper/cardigan and bring their own, clearly named water bottle. Please can we also ask that pupils bring a sun hat and sun cream is applied before school (a labelled bottle can also be brought with them). Please also send a coat/jacket with your child.

There will be **no hot school dinners on this day. If you would like to order a school packed lunch for your child, please let the school office know by Monday 15 June.** Sandwich filling choices are ham, cheese or tuna mayo. **If you do not want a school packed lunch, then please provide one for your child, as there will be no other option on this day.**

If you plan to attend sports day, please bring your own chair!

Nursery children who do not attend nursery on Wednesdays are also invited to join us. If your child would like to come for the day or the afternoon, please let the class teacher know.

Year 6 Leavers Trip

We are looking forward to celebrating our Year 6 pupils with this year's Leavers' Trip to Malton Palace Cinema on Wednesday 8th July.

In preparation for the trip, we gathered the children's votes, and the cinema was their clear favourite! They have also chosen the film they would like to watch and have collectively selected 'Minions and Monsters.' This film is a PG rated film, so if you do not give permission for your child to watch this film, please contact school as soon as possible so that alternative arrangements can be discussed.

Children should come to school as normal on the day. Coaches will collect the children from each school to allow for a prompt 10.30am film start and will collect them at 12.30pm to return to school.

Each child will receive a drink and a portion of popcorn during the visit. Children will be able to choose from a fizzy drink (Coke, Diet Coke, Fanta, Sprite Zero) squash or water on the day. If there are any drinks you would prefer your child not to have, please let your child's teacher know before the trip so this information can be passed on to the cinema.

As the children will return to school after lunch, could we ask that a packed lunch is provided, **if you require a school packed lunch please inform the office by 26th June.**

There will be a voluntary contribution on Arbor of £22.50 per pupil to cover the cost of the trip and transport.

We are sure the children will have a wonderful time celebrating the end of their primary school journey together!

We warmly invite parents, carers, family members and friends to join us for what promises to be a fantastic celebration of the children's hard work and talents.
