

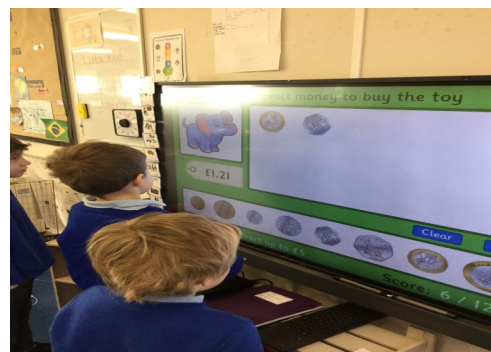
STILLINGTON PRIMARY SCHOOL BULLETIN
