## Uniform update:

We would like to provide you with an important update regarding our uniform policy that has recently been reviewed by governors and to share some important reminders for all students. The policy can be found on our website under the policies tab.

## Key Updates and reminders:

**Footwear:** Students are required to wear **black shoes** as part of the school uniform. Please ensure your child has the correct footwear and children **should not wear trainers or open-toed sandals**.

**Bags:** To ensure all students' belongings, fit safely on their pegs, we ask that pupils use a school book bag, which can be purchased via: <https://www.schooltrends.co.uk/> and a draw string bag used for the PE kits.

**Water Bottles:** Students should bring a **water bottle of no more than 700ml** to stay hydrated throughout the day. Please ensure the bottle is clearly labelled with your child's name.

**Jewellery:** Fashion items are best kept for home, and for reasons such as health, safety and inclusion, fashion accessories such as make-up, nail polish, jewellery, other than stud earrings and watches (no smart watches), should not be worn.

## **Federation and collaboration Update**

Dear Parents,

*The Langton and FST Schools Federation Governors have been working together for some time to explore formalising the collaboration between our 4 schools by creating a new federation.*

*At separate Full Governing Board meetings on 27 March 2025, Governors approved a formal consultation with stakeholders, on a proposal for the four schools to form a new federation, with effect from September 2025.*

*This means, after Easter, there will be a formal six-week consultation with staff, parents and the local communities (of all four schools), with opportunities to find out more about the proposal, ask any questions, and/or provide a formal response. After Easter we will be sending out detailed information about the proposal, along with details about how you can participate and contribute your views during the consultation period.*

*Stakeholder views and consultation responses will be considered in June 2025 by both Governing Boards separately, before they make a final decision on the proposal to federate.*

*Thank you for your support in considering this important decision for our schools.*
