## **PSHE Summer 1**

This half term in PSHE we are looking at keeping ourselves safe.

**In year 1 and 2**, we will be looking at keeping ourselves safe. We will be focusing on following rules when crossing the roads and when on farms, who we contact if there is an emergency and how to stay safe around fire.

**In year 3 and 4**, we will be also how to keep ourselves safe. We will be focusing on understanding what risks are and how to navigate them as well as looking at different hazards that we may come across in and out of school.

We will also be further developing our idea of fire safety.

**In year 5 and 6** we will be talking in more depth about risks and what we can do to keep ourselves safe in different situations. We will also be looking at how to respond if ever faced with an emergency and allowing them to recall their first aid skills. We will finish the half term by discussing things that may make us uncomfortable and how we can find help and support if this is ever the case in order to keep ourselves safe.

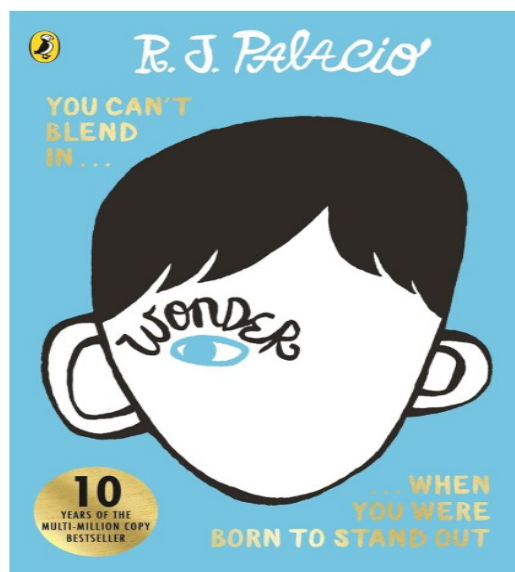

### Wow Work KS2 / YEAR 3 TO 6

It's been great seeing the children back in school after the Easter holidays! They've thrown themselves into their activities with great enthusiasm.

Our new English topic this half term is based on the novel Wonder, by RJ Palacio, and we started the week off by looking

at the different themes in the book. In maths we are looking at a number of different topics including perimeter, fractions and percentages, and we are also starting a new topic in Science around Living Things and their Habitats.



## Beetle Bank Farm

On Tuesday 20th May, nursery and reception will be visiting Beetle Bank farm to take part in a selection of forest-based activities, linked to our 'understanding the world' curriculum. We will be travelling by coach, leaving at 9am so all children will need to be in school at 8:45am to allow for a prompt departure. We will be returning before the end of the school day. All children will need a water bottle and packed lunch. To order a school packed lunch, please email the school office with your choice of ham, cheese or tuna sandwiches before Tuesday 6th May.

We will be outside for the majority of the day so children will need to wear practical clothes according to the weather. If it is hot, children will need a hat and suncream and if it is raining they will need wellies and waterproofs.

To cover the cost of the bus, entrance, and activities, we would appreciate a voluntary contribution of £15 per child, which will be added to parent pay. Please log in to parent pay to give consent for your child to go on the trip.

## Malton Sports Centre KS2 event

On Wednesday 30th of April, the children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be taking part in a cross country and rounders event at Malton Sports Centre. The children are asked to come into school in their uniform and will get changed at school into their PE kits. Children will also need to be wearing their school jumpers.
