REMINDER—PARENT GOVERNOR VACANCIES

I am writing to let you know that there is to be a Parent Governor election.

There will be vacancies for two Parent Governors on our new North Yorkshire Rural Schools Federation Governing Board, with effect from 1st September 2025 when the new federation comes into being.

The new governing board will be made up of 14 governors, of which two are elected by the parents from across the parent body of the four schools.

All parents who have parental responsibility for, or care for, a child or young person registered at Foston CE, Langton, Stillington, or Terrington CE schools on 1st September 2025 are eligible to be a Parent Governor, and to vote in the election.

If you would like to nominate yourself, please read the '[Further Information](#)' section below and then complete the attached Nomination Form, which should be returned to the Executive Headteacher either:

in a sealed envelope marked 'CONFIDENTIAL - Parent Governor Nomination', or

via e-mail marked 'CONFIDENTIAL - Parent Governor Nomination' to consultation@foston.n-yorks.sch.uk

along with:

a signed copy of the disqualification declaration form to indicate eligibility to stand for election

a signed copy of the governors' details declaration

a completed statement in support of your nomination

The closing date for nominations is 12 noon on Tuesday 1st July 2025.

If there are only two nominations received, a ballot does not need to be held, and the nominees will be appointed. If more than two nominations are received, a ballot will be arranged. Should this be the case you will receive further details on how to vote, and information about the candidates standing for election.
