EYFS and Year 1 & 2 – Miss Allwood

We have had a lovely week in the sunshine in class 1 this week. We have made good use of it and have spent lots of time learning outside.

Early years have enjoyed building boats, digging in the stones and play lots of imaginative games together.

KS1 have been outside also, drawing large number lines, hunting for mini beasts in science and doing a little bit of roleplay in English.

Year 3,4,& 6 – Miss Jackson

This week in Key Stage 2 we have been learning how to edit our work in English, which the children have been trying hard at. In maths we have been consolidating our knowledge of place value, we made a place value obstacle course whereby the children come up with a place value question for each year group and a movement break, and everybody had a go at everyone else's questions. In DT this week we have been looking at using pulley systems to transport objects across different areas. We also had Open the Book today, which got lots of the children involved in acting out one of the stories from the Bible.

On Thursday 2nd October we have a Science Bus coming to Stillington, which is going to do an experiment with the children. They are going to be bringing in pigs hearts and lungs for the children to look at, which sounds really fun.
