## Togetherness: Supporting Families in North Yorkshire

### What is Togetherness?

Togetherness is the new name for *In Our Place* in North Yorkshire — a fresh identity that reflects our commitment to building stronger, more connected families and communities. Developed by the **Solihull Approach**, a not-for-profit NHS service, Togetherness offers a wide range of **free online courses** designed to support emotional health, parenting, and relationships for families across the county.



### Why the Change?

The rebranding to *Togetherness* represents:

- A **more inclusive and relatable identity** for families in North Yorkshire.
- A focus on **connection, support, and shared learning**.
- A clearer message that these resources are available to **everyone**, regardless of background or level of need.

### How Do People Use Togetherness?

Togetherness courses are:

- **Completely free** for North Yorkshire residents and professionals.
- **Accessible anytime, anywhere** — courses are delivered online and can be followed at your own pace.
- **Modular and flexible** — short modules fit easily around busy family life.
- **Universal** — available to all families, not just those receiving support.
- **Accessible** – easy to translate in to many different languages

### Getting Started

To access the courses, residents and professionals simply need:

- Their **postcode**, or
- The **access code: NYfamilies**

They can register for **as many courses as they like**.

### Course Library Overview

TogetherNESS offers a wide range of courses tailored to different stages of life:

#### Antenatal

- Understanding pregnancy, labour, birth and your baby
- For women couples

#### Postnatal (0–6 months)

- Understanding your baby
- Understanding your preterm or sick baby (in hospital and at home)

#### Children & Young People (6 months–19+ years)

- Understanding your child: from toddler to teenager
- Understanding your child with additional needs
- Understanding your child's feelings
- Understanding your child's mental health and wellbeing
- Understanding the impact of the pandemic on your child

#### Preteen to Teenager

- Understanding your teenager's brain
- Moving up to secondary school (for children with additional needs)
