### KS2 Residential Queries

As you are aware, we are planning our KS2 residential. We are still awaiting confirmation on prices and information from Beverley Park with regards to finer details. Once we have further information, we will be in touch as well as hosting an information event for all parents.

#### **Attendance**

KS2 Y3-6 from Terrington, Stillington, Foston and Langton will be attending the residential

#### **Staffing**

We will have staff from across the federation attending the residential to ensure our ratio's are compliant. We will share with parents' what staff will be attending the residential when we have confirmed pupil numbers and allocated staff places.

#### **Groupings & Bedrooms**

All pupils will be asked to select 3 friends to be in a room/group with, based on this, we will try our best to ensure that all pupils are with at least one of their chosen friends.

#### **Payments**

The current cost of the trip is £300 per child which is estimated. We will be setting up payment plans to pay instalments throughout the year to cover the costs.

#### **Opportunities**

As part of our long-term plan, KS2 have the opportunity to attend a residential once every two years therefore if your child is currently in Year 3 or 4, they will have another opportunity to attend a residential.

#### **Activities**

As we have not finalised the logistics, we do not yet have a full itinerary to share with parents. Once we have this confirmed, we will share this with parents. Some examples of activities are as followed: zip line, rafting, climbing wall, caving and team building.

#### **Mobile phones**

Mobile phones are not permitted on the residential due to safeguarding. Should we need to contact a parent, school staff will get in touch with parents via telephone or email.

## Wow Class work



### EYFS and Year 1 & 2 – Miss Allwood

Our EYFS children have had a wonderful week exploring their new story *Whatever Next!* They have enjoyed retelling the story, acting out Baby Bear's adventure to the moon, and taking part in a range of creative activities inspired by the book. From building their own rockets to experimenting with space-themed play, the children have shown fantastic curiosity and imagination.

Meanwhile, KS1 have been learning all about Remembrance Day. They have spent time discussing why we remember, exploring symbols such as the poppy, and reflecting on the importance of peace. The children have produced some thoughtful artwork and writing to mark the occasion, showing great sensitivity and understanding.

### Year 3,4,5 & 6 – Miss Jackson

This week in KS2 in English we have been writing our flashback piece of writing. The ideas in our classroom have been very creative, and we have produced some brilliant pieces of work. In maths we are still looking at the 4 operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We are using lots of physical resources to support us, and the children are doing well at independently using these to support them as well.

We went to the Remembrance Service at the church on Tuesday which the children really enjoyed. They got to lay the poppies they had designed at the front of the church during the service, and we learnt lots about why we have a Remembrance Day. In music we are starting to learn the lyrics to our song, which this half term is 'I want to break free' by Queen. In RE this week, we are looking at the Creation Story and making a story board for the 7 days when God created the world.

### Emergency Contact Information Required For All Pupils

There have been a few changes recently around the guidance for emergency contact telephone numbers schools hold for children, especially for our early years children. The guidance now states that more than 2 emergency contacts should be held for early years children as part of safeguarding and welfare requirements set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage Framework. We feel as a school this is good practice and ask that all parents, please check their Arbor app to make sure there are 3 emergency contact numbers for your child/children. Please note, as a school we would always start with the first contact in an emergency and work down the list. Thank you for your assistance with this.
