#### **EYFS and Year 1 & 2 – Miss Allwood**

Our EYFS children have had a lovely week completing their Diya lamps, taking great care decorating them and learning more about why they are used during Diwali. They have also started to explore the celebration of Christmas, enjoying stories, crafts and early discussions about the traditions that make this time of year so special.

In KS1, the children have been busy using their imaginations to create alternative endings to their fairy tale stories. They've enjoyed thinking about what might happen next, adding new twists, characters and ideas to make their stories unique and exciting.

#### **Y3,4,5,6 – Miss Jackson**

This week in Key Stage 2 we have started our fractions topic in Years 5 and 6, and Years 3 and 4 have been looking at their times tables. In English this week we have started to plan our letter in a 1<sup>st</sup> person style to the character's wife whilst they are at war.

In Science Years 3 and 4 have been doing an experiment to look at how different drinks can affect our teeth. Years 5 and 6 have been looking at how different legal drugs affect the body – alcohol and tobacco. In French we are continuing to learn about different items in the classroom, and we have been able to ask questions to each other asking for different classroom objects. On Thursday it is our school nativity and Christingle service, children are asked to bring in some black trousers or legging and a Christmas jumper or top, to change into ready for this service.
